Winter Weather Operations 02-15-2019**

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE:

The City of Raytown has put the Snow Ordinance in effect as of 1:00 p.m. today. We recommend staying off of the roads if you don't have to go out. If you do have to go out after it starts please be patient, allow extra time, be cautious on elevated surfaces and give the snow plows extra room.

Emergency Snow Ordinance Information:

Sec. 42-305. - Snow emergency regulations; obstructing traffic; emergency snow routes.

(a) DRIVING EMERGENCY: Drivers are required to have snow tires or chains on their vehicles. Drivers who do not have chains or snow tires and become "stalled" on the streets may be ticketed.

(b) PARKING EMERGENCY: Drivers must remove all vehicles parked on designated snow routes.

Emergency snow routes are as follows:

- (1) Blue Ridge Cutoff.
- (2) Blue Ridge Boulevard.
- (3) Raytown Road.
- (4) Raytown Trafficway.
- (5) Sterling from Blue Ridge Boulevard to north city limit.
- (6) Woodson Road from Blue Ridge Boulevard to 75th Street.
- (7) Westridge.
- (8) 53rd Street from Woodson Road to Raytown Road.
- (9) 55th Street from west city limit to Raytown Road.
- (10) 56th Street from Raytown Road to Blue Ridge Boulevard.
- (11) 59th Street.
- (12) 63rd Street.
- (13) 67th Street.
- (14) Terrace from Lane to Raytown Road.
- (15) Gregory Boulevard.
- (16) 75th Street from Elm to Westridge.
- (17) 79th Street from Raytown Road to west city limit.
- (18) 83rd Street.
- (19) 87th Street from Raytown Road to west city limit.
