With the City of Raytown's current State of Emergency and Jackson County's stay-at-home order, which goes into effect Tuesday, March 24th, 2020, City Administration reviewed if any modifications should be made to the services provided by the City of Raytown. At this time, it has been determined that City services will continue to be provided at their current levels. The Raytown Municipal Court has updated their schedule of upcoming court dates and their new schedule is posted on the City website.
