



The City of Raytown has announced a special arrangement they have made with Compost Connection to collect storm debris curbside during the next 2 months.

2 free Green Vouchers can be obtained at Raytown City Hall during normal business hours at the Public Works Dept. office from January 28th through March 29th.

Green Vouchers must be redeemed February 1st through April 12th, 2019. Compost Connection's current schedule is to collect on Fridays. Property Owner must contact Compost Connection prior to noon each Thursday to schedule a Friday pick-up.

Two Green Vouchers covers the cost for pick-up and up to 25 bags or 25 bundles.

All storm debris needs to be bundled in 18" x 36" long bundles, double tied with rope/twine or contained in paper lawn waste bags. Bundles and bags must be less than 50 pounds.

Compost Connection will take logs up to 6" in diameter if they are bundled in bundles of 3. No "firewood" or stacks of individual logs.

Property Owner must email the 2 Vouchers to Compost Connection prior to scheduled pick-up date, or tape the 2 Vouchers to the front door of Property no later than 7:00 am Friday morning of scheduled pick-up.

If you cannot complete your cleanup prior to April 12th, Please contact Compost Connection for details on year round programs available for purchase.
