# Why Not Expand Your Family by Four Feet?

- ▶ **Pet License**
- ▶ **Rabies Vaccination**
- ▶ **Pet owners**

# Animal Control Division

- ▶ We handle over 600 animals a year and our partnership with Midwest Animal ResQ has increased the number of lost or homeless pets adopted.
- ▶ Many animals have been saved and are now living happy, healthy lives with their new families
- ▶ Our focus is on promoting identification, lost pet reunions, and pet ownership education throughout the community.

**License required.** Any person who shall keep or harbor upon the person's premises a dog, cat, ferret, or pot-bellied pig over the age of 90 days shall obtain a license for the same from the director within 14 days of bringing such animal into the city.

**Duration, renewal of license.** Such license shall be valid from the date of issuance until the expiration date of the applicable animal's rabies vaccination. Licenses shall be renewed on or before the date that the rabies vaccination expires.

## Goals and objectives:

- ▶ Allowing pet owners to obtain a 1, 2, or 3-year pet license
- ▶ Offer free microchip with a Three-year pet license
- ▶ Increase number of animals with microchip
- ▶ Track and increase the number of animals to be reunited with their owners
- ▶ Increase pet ownership



## Advantage of doing a 2,or 3 year Pet license.

- Save staff time and effort on data entry, subsequently save money
- Reduce frequency of front counter customer service
- Reduce amount of paper printout
- Reduce number of Tags used
- Fewer citation for Pet License violation
