

RE: AMENDMENT TO COVID-19 STATE OF EMERGENCY

On March 12, 2020, in accordance with the power vested in me by the Constitutional Home Rule Charter of Jackson County, Missouri, and the laws of this state and county, I proclaimed a State of Emergency for Jackson County due to the public health threat caused by the spread of COVID-19. Due to subsequent developments, including the existence of "community spread" of the COVID-19 virus in the metropolitan area, and on the recommendation of the County's Director of Health, Bridgette Casey, MPH, I am hereby amending my prior order, as follows:

Section 1. For purposes of this Order, the term "Large Group Event" means any gathering of ~~4,000~~ 250 or more people for any business, professional, social, cultural, entertainment, or other special event where people are not separated by physical space of at least four feet (which is slightly longer than an average arm's length).

The aforementioned amendment shall be effective immediately and shall remain in effect until further order or upon the expiration of the current State of Emergency.
