This course begins **August 21, 2018**. The program will meet and exceed all the requirements for the Emergency Medical Technician Basic Education as outlined by the Missouri Bureau of EMS and the United States Department of Transportation curriculum.

Upon successful completion of this course, the student is eligible for the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians psychomotor and cognitive exams for the EMT-Basic. Once these exams are successfully completed, the student may then apply for state licensure as an EMT-Basic.
