Job Description: To perform various semi-skilled and unskilled maintenance activities related to public works infrastructure, and to perform a variety of manual tasks relative to assigned areas of responsibility.

Required Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

Essential Functions:

1. Regular and predictable attendance as agreed upon with supervisor. Maintain a positive work atmosphere by acting and communicating in ways that foster good relationships with customers, coworkers, and managers.
2. Perform various tasks related to the maintenance and repair of city streets, including mowing rights-of-way, fixing potholes, trimming trees, and cleaning ditches; perform various tasks related to the repair and maintenance of sewer lines, including cleaning sewer lines and digging up and replacing sewer mains.
3. Operate various light equipment, including mowers, tillers, pickup trucks, chain saws, and other equipment as needed.
4. Assist with the cleaning out of clogged sewer lines; operate snowplow during wintertime; trim trees and haul brush to be mulched.
5. Perform street cuts and clean driveway ditches and storm drains; raise maintenance holes.
6. Adhere to safe work practices and procedures.
