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**Action Requested:** A finding from the Sales Tax Oversight Committee (STOC) that Patrol tourniquets meet the intent of the Public Safety Sales Tax.

**Recommendation:** Recommend approval as submitted.

**Analysis:** The Police Department provides tourniquets and tourniquet use training for field personnel for first aid use when presented with cases of life-threatening bleeding. Tourniquets have been successfully applied by field personnel, saving lives. However, tourniquets are single-use devices and must be replenished and reissued. This purchase of tourniquets will provide a tourniquet in every patrol car to ensure that they are available when the life-threatening emergency is encountered. The cost of each tourniquet, with shipping, is approximately \$26.00 each. This requested expenditure, not to exceed \$370.00 will equip each patrol car with one tourniquet and provide two spares.

**Tourniquets for Patrol Officers vehicles:** This purchase will equip Raytown patrol vehicles with life-saving tourniquets.

**Alternative:** Not provide the tourniquets and reduce life-saving capabilities.

**Recommendation:** Recommend approval as submitted.

**Analysis:** The Records Department is responsible for retaining records of various formats as well as the responsibility to maintain access to these various records. The Records Unit stores microfilm reels of archived records and a microfilm reader. Maintaining the microfilm reader has become more difficult over the last few years, some parts are obsolete, and some supplies are no longer being manufactured. Currently the Records Unit has 114 reels of film that still need to be converted to digital. It is necessary to convert these reels in a timely fashion to avoid the full loss of our microfilm reader capabilities.

The Records Unit is asking for approval to spend \$8,150.00. This amount will cover the retrieval of original reels from Underground Vaults and Storage and the conversion of 84 reels of microfilm from Casey Associates, Inc. It is anticipated that the remainder reels will be completed within the FY22 budget year.

**Records Unit Microfilm Conversion:** This purchase will convert microfilm to digital files to be used within the computer system.

**Alternative:** Not converting files will result in an inability to access and provide records as required by law.

**Analysis:** Prisoners often must remain in custody to await trial or serve time, sentenced by the Raytown Municipal Court. The Raytown Detention Unit is not equipped to properly house those prisoners, due to facility limitations. The Raytown Detention Unit is only able to temporarily hold prisoners until they are released or transported to the off-site prisoner detention facility. Thus, prisoners being held more than a short period of time must be held at an off-site detention facility until their court date or their sentence is served.

Prisoner housing fees are only incurred as services are provided. The exact amount needed is unknown at this time but is not expected to be more than \$76,000.00.

**Alternative:** Not approve the off-site facility fees and not be able to hold prisoners.

**Barracuda Mail Archiver Maintenance** – This is support maintenance for the Barracuda Mail archiver that allows for the long term storage and retrieval of e-mail traffic from the network. The cost is \$660.00 - PSST

**StarWitness Support and Maintenance-** In 2016 the Police Department purchased an updated interview system for criminal investigations. The software is proprietary to the product and maintenance is renewed on an annual basis. The support plan includes software and maintenance including updates, releases, bug fixes, and technical support for StarWitness Interviewer and Field Interviewer. The cost of renewal is \$2473.20 – PSST

**Veeam-** One year software license renewal for Veeam Backup, Replication and Recovery protection for physical servers. This replaces our annual maintenance for the Eversync 2700 backup array, which will be end of life in February 2021. The cost is – \$1900.00 – PSST

**Microsoft 365-** One year renewal of the Departments Microsoft 365 email, device management services and productivity apps that are installed on 11 workstations. The cost is - \$1482.00- PSST

However, not all law enforcement situations require or allow for the transport of a person to the Raytown Police Department for the purpose of determining their identity. In these situations, mobile fingerprint scanners can be used at the location of the law enforcement contact and provides the opportunity to immediately identify the subject. The IDEMIA MorphoDent is a handheld Bluetooth device that operates upon the same platform as the LiveScan.

This project proposal includes the purchase of one MorphoDent mobile fingerprint scanner with a one-year maintenance program.

This purchase will not exceed 2021 budgeted funds for the Police Department.

**Analysis:** The Police Department utilizes an IT replacement schedule that is an annual recurring list of IT equipment reaching their useful service life. The new equipment is to ensure infrastructure reliability and mitigate large IT expenses in any single year.

The Police Department needs to replace our SAN storage device that functions as the primary storage for the Department's virtualized servers and applications. The storage device will house mission critical data and applications such as our records management system, dispatch databases and digital evidence. Due to the critical nature of the data being stored, this SAN has fully redundant storage, connectivity, and power systems. The SAN storage device this will replace has reached its anticipated useful life as it has been in service just over 5 years.

The cost of this items will not exceed \$27,000.00.
